CESPHN Engagement Strategy 2022-25

Allied health is attracting strategic attention federally and features significantly in the consultation draft of Australia's Primary Health Care 10 Year Plan 2022-2032. The need to develop an AHP Engagement Strategy has been consistently raised by CESPHN's advisory councils and is now reflected in the CESPHN Strategic Plan 2022-25.

The Allied Health Engagement Strategy describes CESPHN's commitment to supporting AHPs in quality improvement activities and their greater participation in primary healthcare activities.

In the earliest stages, the strategy aims to address topics of local need and enhance AHP's adoption and operation of systems that connect them to general practice and the broader health system. CESPHN Engagement Strategy will work to promote:

- Use of quality improvement frameworks endorsed by the relevant AHP professional peak body;
- Better use of electronic clinical information systems;
- Increased use of eHealth, such as MHR, Secure Messaging and Telehealth, and
- Greater opportunities for professional development and local networking.

Central and Eastern Sydney PHN will be releasing the CESPHN Allied Health Engagement Strategy 2022-2025 in March 2022. This strategy will provide a strong platform for CESPHN to increase support to allied health and enable allied health professionals to build stronger connections with other health professionals and promote continued professional development.
