

# FOOT CARE OPTIONS WITHIN THE SYDNEY LOCAL HEALTH DISTRICT



### Normal feet, Inability to self-care (eg frail elderly, vision impaired, disabled)

Refer to a private podiatrist. See the Podiatry Association website: www.podiatry.org.au If >65, refer for foot care via My Aged Care for frail elderly (www.myagedcare.gov.au Ph: 1800200422). NDIS eligible clients may include podiatry in their plan.



#### Foot pathology + Low risk of foot ulcer/amputation (LOPS or PAD + deformity)

Refer to a private podiatrist, MyAgedCare, NDIS depending on eligibility or Refer to SLHD podiatry hospital care if clinically indicated\* - submit a referral via **HealthLink** Smart, or send an SLHD podiatry intake form or referral letter via **email**: SLHD-Podiatry@health.nsw.gov.au.



# Moderate - High risk of foot ulcer/amputation (LOPS &/or PAD +/- prev foot ulcer, amputation or ESRD

Refer to a private podiatrist or Refer to SLHD Podiatry if hospital-based care is clinically indicated\*.



## Foot ulcer, infection or suspected Charcot Foot

Urgent referral to a High Risk Foot Service (HRFS), if they live in the SLHD:

#### Foot infection associated with systemic features (SIRS) or Acute limb ischaemia

Refer immediately to local emergency department

#### Sydney Local Health District (SLHD) podiatry service locations:

Canterbury, Concord, Balmain and Royal Prince Alfred Hospitals. Croydon and Marrickville Health Centres.







#### **SLHD podiatry services:**

- Multidisciplinary management of foot ulceration, infection and Charcot Foot.
- Preventative foot care for people at Moderate High risk of diabetes-related foot disease and people receiving renal replacement therapy (dialysis).
- Telehealth and phone consultation to assist in the shared care management of foot pathology.
- Biomechanical review as part of the Osteoarthritis Chronic Care Program.
- CHSP provider for the provision of foot care for frail elderly people >65 (referrals must be submitted via My Aged Care Portal <a href="https://www.myagedcare.gov.au">www.myagedcare.gov.au</a> or Tel: 1800 200 422).



#### Referral considerations\*:

- Referral must reside in the SLHD catchment.
- Appointments are allocated based on the risk of developing foot complications, foot pathology, relevant co-morbidities, indigenous status, mental health and financial disadvantage.
- Foot ulceration, Charcot Foot (diabetes-related foot disease) are given priority appointments.
- The SLHD is not an NDIS provider.
