REMINDER FOR 20 WEEK GP VISIT

- PLEASE DO NOT COPY RHW INTO REFERRALS FOR PATHOLOGY AND ULTRASOUNDS. PROVIDE THE WOMAN WITH THE HARD COPY OF THE RESULTS, TO BRING TO THE NEXT RHW VISIT. THIS SAVES PAPER AND DOUBLE HANDLING OF RESULTS.
- If the Morphology ultrasound identifies a Fetal anomaly or you have a concern regarding genetic screening please call the RHW MFM Department on **0437 537 448 (Mon-Fri 9-4pm)**, to discuss your concerns and where appropriate to request an appointment. This number is available for medical and midwifery clinicians. **It is not a patient referral number.**
- Ensure the Morphology Ultrasound result is written on the yellow card and give a copy of the results to the woman, to bring to the next RHW visit.
- Provide a referral for the routine 26-28 week bloods (FBC, Ferritin, 2hr 75mg OGTT, Blood group and antibody screen). Please advise the woman to do these bloods **AFTER** 26 weeks of pregnancy.
- Educate and reiterate to the woman to call the Delivery Suite on the 24hour contact number **0439 869 035**, with any urgent pregnancy concerns.
