Vaccine Deliveries

Before accepting the delivery and transferring the vaccines to a dedicated vaccine refrigerator, check the cold chain monitors.


There are two types of cold chain monitors:

- Freeze indicator
- Heat indicator

It is important to confirm that the cold chain has been maintained during transport and the integrity of the vaccines has not been compromised.


1. Freeze indicators

If the bulb on the Coldmark monitor is purple you must <u>not</u> use the vaccines as they will have been exposed to temperatures $\leq 0^{\circ}$ C.



2. Heat indicators

This bioCSL Time Temperature Indicator changes from "satisfactory" to "unsatisfactory" as vaccines are exposed to temperatures over 8°C



If the cold chain monitor(s) has <u>activated</u>, contact the NSW Vaccine Centre immediately on **1300 656 132**. While awaiting advice, the vaccines MUST be:

(TTI) Label Color Guide

- placed in the refrigerator
- isolated
- labelled 'DO NOT USE'
- · Record the breach on the back of the vaccine temperature chart
