COLD CHAIN BREACH PROCESS



Is it a cold chain breach?

- Temperature above 12°C? Cold Chain Breach
- Temperature below 2°C? Cold Chain Breach
- Between 8°C to 12°C? Check duration: Longer than 15 minutes? Cold Chain Breach

What to do following a cold chain breach:

- 1. Immediately QUARANTINE vaccines
- 2. Label fridge "DO NOT USE, DO NOT DISCARD" and advise all staff
- 3. Report breach to Public Health Unit (PHU)
- 4. DO NOT use the vaccines until further instruction from the Public Health Unit
- 5. DO NOT discard the vaccines until further instruction from the Public Health Unit

How to report a breach:

- 1. You will need the following documents:
 - a. Completed <u>Cold Chain Breach and Vaccine Wastage Reporting Form (fill out electronically)</u>
 - b. Data Logger graph and 5 minute report
 - c. Min/max temperature chart
- 2. Email to your Public Health Unit at
 - a. <u>SESLHD-PublicHealthUnit-IMMTeam@health.nsw</u>.gov.au
 - b. SLHD-Immunisation@health.nsw.gov.au

Next steps - What to do with the vaccines:

- 1. Keep vaccines QUARANTINED DO NOT use, DO NOT discard
- 2. Public Health Unit will email the form back to you with advice
- 3. You will be provided with instructions on which vaccines to "retain" and which vaccines to "discard"
- 4. "Retain" vaccines are required to be labelled with the Cold chain breach sticker:
