



## Human Research Recruitment Advertisement Re-design of the CESPHN GP Mental Health Shared Care Program

## Help improve physical health care for people with mental illness by improving Shared Care between GPs and Mental Health Services

Researchers at the International Centre for Future Health Systems UNSW are conducting a research project to inform the redesign of the CESPHN GP Mental Health Shared Care program.

The research study is looking to recruit people who meet the following criteria:

- People who use (or have previously used) Adult Community Mental Health Services in Sydney Local Health District (SLHD), South Eastern Sydney Local Health District (SESLHD or St Vincents Health Network (SVHN)
- 2. Family members or other carers of people who use Adult Community Mental Health Services in SLHD, SESLHD or SVHN.
- 3. Health services providers or other stakeholders who have had some engagement or interest in shared care between GPs and mental health services in the Central and South Eastern Sydney region

Participants will be excluded from the study if they are:

- 1. unable or unwilling to provide informed consent to participate.
- 2. under 18 years of age.

Participants will be asked to participate in a Focus Group.
