

Syphilis rates are on the rise in Australia. General practitioners (GPs) are often the first point of contact for patients with sexually transmitted infections (STIs), making their role vital in the early detection and management of syphilis. Additionally, the first test for pregnant women will be done by a GP.

This auditing activity will support GPs in South Eastern Sydney to increase syphilis screening and effectively and comprehensively manage a syphilis case.
