DFSV Assist aims to improve primary care responses to domestic, family and sexual violence and child sexual abuse through training, consultations, referral support and system integration initiatives. Our new service, DFSV Health Assist, imbeds primary health care into refuges.

- Identify and discuss possible risks and associated mitigation strategies as they emerge
- Identify practice improvements that support Health Professionals to provide traumainformed care
- Review training and other material and provide feedback

Who we are looking for:

We are looking for a Psychologist who has:

- An understanding of issues related to domestic and family violence, sexual violence and/or child sexual abuse within a primary care context;
- A sound understanding the indicators and health impacts on patients who have experienced complex trauma in the context of domestic and family violence / sexual violence and/or child sexual abuse;
- Experience or strong interest and understanding in providing trauma informed care, specifically related to domestic and family violence, sexual violence and/or child sexual abuse.

Time commitment:

The Advisory Committee meets quarterly for 1.5 hours on a Wednesday evening. On rare occasions there might be an ad hoc meeting or some out of session feedback sought via email. Primary Care Practitioner membership is reviewed annually.
