Virtual Fracture Service



The new Virtual Fracture Service (VFS) at Prince of Wales Hospital (POWH) is a triage service for acute Orthopaedic fractures and injuries. This service has been designed as an ED avoidance strategy. Refer directly to POWH fracture services to ease demands on ED and improve patient experience.

Referrals are reviewed by an Orthopaedic Consultant and Physiotherapist before they are triaged to the most appropriate fracture service for follow up. Eligible patients will be offered virtual management provided by a Physiotherapist.

The VFS is a free, public, service for eligible patients that accepts direct GP and Urgent Care Centre referrals. Information about the service and referral process can be found on SES Health Pathways under:
