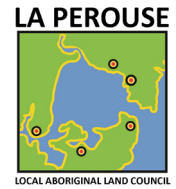

### The Opportunity

Currently this service operates one day a week, we are seeking to expand the service and are looking for an experienced and passionate **General Practitioner** to join our team. This role offers the chance to make a meaningful impact by providing high-quality, culturally safe health care in a supportive and community-focused environment.
