Patients with **unmet palliative care needs** and a **prognosis of less than 24 months.**



Patients needing help with **discharge planning** to **specialist disability accommodation.**



Patients with **2 or more hospital admissions or emergency visits** in the **last 12 months.**



Patients needing **home visits** for **palliative care** but **not eligible** for **Specialist Community Palliative Care Support Services.**

Support for disability accommodation staff to implement the care plan.



Training for health staff in disability supports and services.
