



“Engaging in the PIPE-MC program will strengthen your capacity as a health professional to care for women and families with perinatal mental health and psychosocial concerns.

PIPE-MC is a simulation based, interprofessional education program co-designed to strengthen the capacity of health professionals to care for women and their families with perinatal mental health concerns. A key focus of the program is to build skills in interprofessional collaboration using trauma informed principles.
