

# INFORMATION SHEET

## How to find eligible patients who have not had a Shingles immunisation in PENCAT.

### Target

Proportion of regular patients aged 70-79 who have not been immunised against shingles. A person is immunised against shingles if they have received a course of shingles vaccine (either Zostavax or Shingrix).

### CAT4 Starting Point:

- CAT Open - CAT4 view (all reports) loaded
- Population Extract Loaded and Extract Pane 'Hidden'
  - Filter Pane open and under 'General' tab 'Active Patients' (3 x in 2 yrs) selected

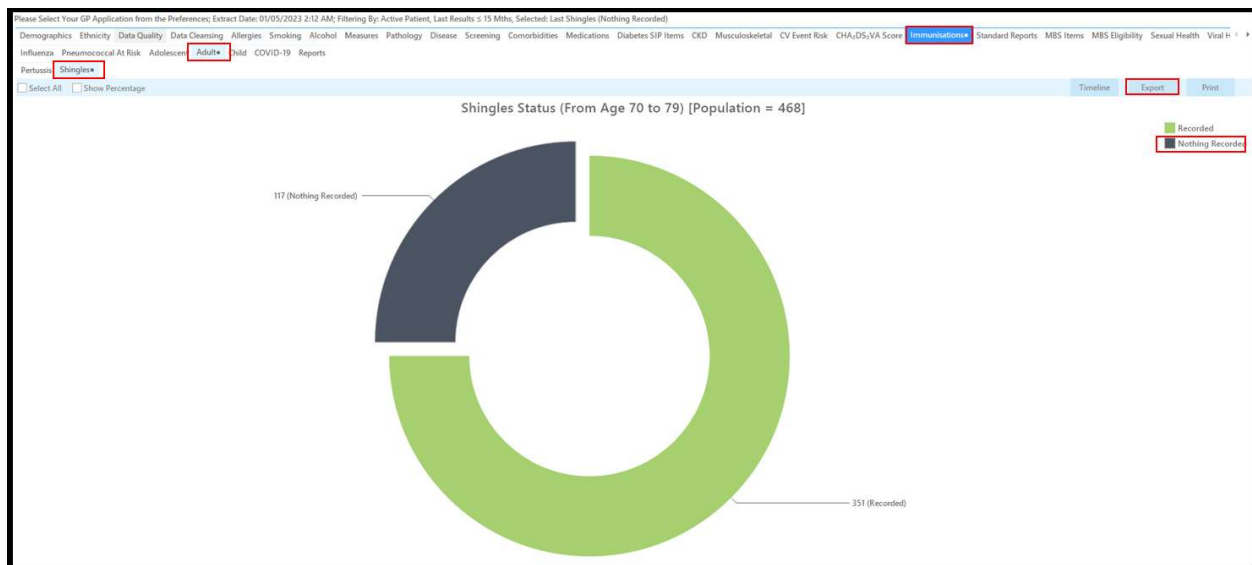


- Click 'Recalculate'
- Click 'Hide Filters'

# INFORMATION SHEET

## Report Steps:

- Select the Immunisation / Adult / Shingles tab
- Select 'Nothing Recorded' on the left hand side
  - The section of patients with 'Nothing Recorded' are eligible patients who **have not** had a shingles vaccine
- Select 'Export' to generate a Patient List



## To export Patient List to Microsoft Excel:

- Click on the Export Icon at the top of the Patient Reidentification window
- Click on 'Excel'
- Choose a file name and a location to save to
- Click 'Save'
